## Important Eligibility and Registration Information

### **SR-Motorcycle Training**

Is the local organization with conducts California Motorcycle Training, a state-wide program for beginning and experienced motorcycle riders sponsored by the California Highway Patrol. Classrooms and riding sessions are held at the Sonoma County Fairgrounds. The Department of Motor Vehicles now waives it's riding skills test requirements for a Class M1 or M2 license for applicants who have successfully complete the Course.

### **Length of Course**

The course include five hours of classroom training and ten hours of on cycle experience in a two day format on weekends or a two week format on weekdays. It begins with a classroom lecture and discussion or riding range first depending on which format you choose. Please call ahead for exact format being used at that time, such as Summer schedule or Winter schedule.

Each exercise in each session builds cumulatively on the skills and information from the preceding exercises and discussions. Therefore, each student must attend all class or range sessions in order to complete the course and be issued a DL389 form for DMV.

### **What the Student needs to provide**

The student must have eye protection, sturdy full fingered gloves, over the ankle footwear, and long sleeves shirt or jacket.

### **To enroll in any motorcycle/scooter class you**

- Have a valid drivers license or a valid learners permit or
- Proof of successful completion of a drivers education program

### **SR-Motorcycle Training Provides....**

We provide the motorcycles for the range training, along with helmets and a controlled learning environment.

### **What is the cost**

The course costs are \$250.00 for those 21 years of age or older, \$150.00 for those 20 years and younger.

### **How often are classes held**

We offer several classes throughout each month year round you may visit our website or call us to get most current class schedules.

### **What if I am under 18**

On the first session a parent or legal guardian must be present to sign all forms.

### **To enter any motorcycle/scooter class you must be:**

- At least 15 years 6 months old
- In good health

*At the first classroom/range students younger than 18 MUST have a parent or legal guardian accompany them to the classroom/range in order to sign waivers.*

### **What is the ratio of students to RiderCoaches**

We never exceed a ratio of 1 RiderCoach to 6 students in a range session

### **Do you offer One to One training**

Please call for more information on this subject. We do have such training however it is **NOT PART OR ASSOCIATED IN ANY WAY WITH ANY TRAINING MATERIALS** from Motorcycle Safety Foundation or the California Motorcycle Safety Program. Again please call for more information on this subject.

### **How do I register for the Basic or Experienced rider course**

The fastest and easiest way is to call our office, and register over

the phone with a VISA, MASTERCARD, or check debit card. You may also fill out the registration application, sign it, and mail it with a check or money order for your training fee. We keep class size small, so please register early, as classes fill-up fast. Whether you call or mail in your registration, your class assignment will be sent by return mail.

Failure to attend your pre-registered class or cancellation less than 5 business days before the first class will require a rebooking fee of \$150.00 payable up front.

### **There are not refunds for any reason**

We do not guarantee you will master the written or riding skills presented in this course. Most of the time students successfully complete the course their first time, some need additional training. ***If you do not pass the course your first time or have been asked to leave and invited to return, you may repeat the course at no additional charge provide it is done so within a 3 month time period. However if you do not re-attend within the 3 month grace period, you will have forfeited your spot. And will have to pay full price in order to re-attend.***

### **How big are the motorcycles/scooters that are used**

We use a variety of motorcycle styles from a standard motorcycle style to dual sports. They vary in height and weight; engine sizes from 80cc to 500cc including scooter.

### **Do you have classes in the rain**

We ride rain or shine, hot or cold, clear or foggy. However a class can be canceled if weather dictates it.
